Properties

BRILALIT venti-ground 3 in 1 LH-67 is a pigmented, filling special alkyd resin paint with ventilating vapour permeability. BRILALIT has a high degree of elasticity and penetration, allowing the natural contraction and expansion of the wood to occur without cracking or loss of adhesion. BRILALIT is also characterized by excellent flow, high opacity and good edge coverage combined with fast sandability.

Field of application

As a primer, intermediate and final coat for exterior and interior wood-based materials on doors, window frames, shutters, garage doors, panelling, cupboards, furniture, railings, soffits, etc.

Pretreatment

The wood to be treated must be clean, dry (not more than 15 % wood moisture), free of wax and resin.

Processing

Do not use below 8 °C. Subsequent intermediate sanding with 180–220 grit should be carried out.

System structure

As a primer

1 x transparent wood impregnation base SILAXOL (optional)

1 x BRILALIT venti-ground 3 in 1 LH-67

BRILALIT can be painted over with all commercial solvent-based and water-based alkyd and acrylic PU systems.

As 3 in 1 system

2-3 x BRILALIT venti-ground 3 in 1 LH-67

For old and heavily weathered woodwork it is recommended to apply a primer coat of 1 x SILAXOL wood impregnating primer KW-90

Drying

- Dust dry after about 1 hour
- ♦ Firm to the touch after 2-3 hours
- Sandable and recoatable after approx. 12 hours (depending on the temperature, application quantity, air humidity and absorbency of the substrate)

Dilution

Depending on the absorbency of the substrate, BRILALIT should be diluted with approximately 10 % synthetic resin thinner or turpentine substitute (Sangayol). In the spraying process also universal thinner if necessary.

Extensiveness

6-8 m² per kg per application, depending on the quantity applied and the condition of the substrate.


Application

Brush, roller, spray gun or immersion bath.


Cleaning


Clean tools immediately after use with paint or cleaning thinner.













Delivery form Packages of 25, 12 and 6 kg as well as 750ml and 375ml. Colour shades in the COLORAMA-Mix tinting

system in packages of 5 and 2,5 litres as well as 1000ml and 500ml.

Shelf life BRILALIT can be stored for at least 18 months in the well closed original container. Store in a cool and

dry place.

Solid content 78 ± 1 % (average value, depending on the colour tone)
